She serves on S.A.V.O.A.D. (San Antonio Voluntary Organizations) active in disaster relief. She has led the following walks in her church under the team; <u>Brookhill Holy Walkers</u>, Relay for Life Cancer, Alzheimer's, NAMI and Suicide Out of Darkness Walk. She is currently on the Alzheimer's walk committee alongside Mike Canales.

She recently celebrated her 45th Wedding Anniversary to Pastor Aaron Treanor of Brookhill Baptist Church. And she absolutely loves her daughter Sierra, husband Travis and two grandkids Brynn and Barrett of Corpus Christi.
